- ·Return: To Soraypampa for lunch with regional dishes.
- ·Return to Cusco: End of the day.

SACRED VALLEY TOUR + **CONNECTION TO AGUAS** CALIENTES



BE AWARE OF THE EFFECTS OF ALTITUDE, CUSCO IS LOCATED 3,300M ABOVE SEA LEVEL SO IT IS COMMON TO EXPERIENCE SYMPTOMS OF ALTITUDE SICKNESS. MAKE SURE TO DRINK PLENTY OF WATER, AVOID ALCOHOL.





THE CULTURE IN PERU IS VERY DIVERSE, SO IT IS IMPORTANT TO BE RESPECTFUL OF LOCAL TRADITIONS AND CUSTOMS. WHEN VISITING TEMPLES OR SACRED SITES, BE SURE TO DRESS APPROPRIATELY AND FOLLOW THE RULES OF BEHAVIOR.

WE ASK THAT YOU DO NOT TAKE PHOTOS WITH PEOPLE WITH BABY ANIMALS SUCH AS LLAMAS, SHEEP, ALPACAS SINCE THESE POOR ANIMALS SUFFER ANIMAL ABUSE.
