ITINERARY

ARRIVAL IN CUSCO AND ASTROTOURISM CONNECTION WITH THE SACRED CITY

Morning (8:00 - 12:00):

Arrival at Alejandro Velasco Astete International Airport in Cusco (3,399 masl).

Transfer to a 3-star hotel in the historic center.

Rest and acclimatization (coca tea, hydration).

Afternoon (14:00 - 18:00): City tour and the Andean worldview.

Visit to the Koricancha (Inca temple), where we have a guided tour about the importance of astronomy in the cultures that developed in the Andes.

Tour of Sacsayhuaman (Inca temple), highlighting its megalithic architecture, location and importance in the Andean cosmovision.

Night (19:00):

Thematic scene







STELLAR HIKE TO HUCHUY QOSQO (HOMESTAY)

Morning (8:00 - 13:00):

Transfer to Tambomachay (3,700 msnm), start of the hike.

Hike to Huchuy Qosqo (3,600 msnm): Inca trails, Andean landscapes.

Approximate distance: 10 km (moderate to demanding walk).

Afternoon (1:00pm - 6:00pm):

Arrival in Huchuy Qosqo, exploration of the archaeological site.

Homestay experience in a local community: Evening:

Dinner prepared by the host family Starry Night: Astrotourism, Andean worldview and the relationship with dark skies, observation of constellations and interpretation in the Andes.



DAY STAR WALK DAY 2 OF **HUCHUY QOSQO PIURAY** MISMINAY: A JOURNEY TO THE STARS

Morning (8:00 - 13:00):

Hike from Huchuy Qosqo to Chinchero.

Approximate distance: 12 km (moderate to demanding walk). Transfer to the community of Ocotuan in the Piuray lagoon. Lunch prepared by the community hosts

(Pachamanca) on the shores of the Piuray lagoon.

Afternoon (14:00 - 18:00):

 Visit to the Cheqoq archaeological site Visit to Misminay (3,750 masl): Homestay experience in another local community.

Evening:

Dinner prepared by the host family.

STELLAR FAREWELL: VISIT TO MORAY AND **SALINERAS**

Morning (8:00 - 12:00):

Breakfast

Participation in local activities, wise artisans show knowledge about iconography, ancestral techniques, representing the "Hatunmayo" (Milky Way from the Andean worldview perspective).

Cultural exchange, about the community, the Andean worldview through astrotourism. I recommend it because in the morning they are more organized, in the afternoon it is a bit tiring.

Option A: Transfer to the Moray complex and the Maras Salt Mines (3,300 meters above sea level):

Guided tour and learning about salt extraction.

Return to Cusco.

Option B: Transfer to Moray and the Maras Salt Mines (3,300 meters above sea level):

Guided tour and learning about salt extraction.

Transfer to Ollantaytambo for connection to Machu Picchu.
