### ACTIVITIES

### 1 🥊 Pisaq

We will begin our tour by going deep into the Urubamba Valley until we reach Pisaq, a charming mestizo town that combines the old with the modern. We will explore its traditional market, where you will find a wide variety of indigenous crafts and textiles. You will also have the opportunity to appreciate the typical costumes of the region and witness the old commercial customs. Don't forget to visit the colonial church, which still holds mass in Quechua on Sundays, and marvel at the irrigation system and the Incan astronomical observatory.

# 2 💡 Urubamba

We will continue our journey passing through the picturesque villages of Coya, Lamay, Calca and Yucay. During the 45-minute drive, you will enjoy beautiful natural landscapes until you reach Urubamba, a welcoming place in the heart of the Sacred Valley. Here, you will delight yourself with a delicious lunch in a typical restaurant, taking advantage of the comfortable and fertile environment that made this area an important pre-Hispanic agricultural center.

### 3 💡 Ollantaytambo

In the afternoon, we will head towards Ollantaytambo, known as the "Tambo Valley". This ancient Inca city, which stretches along the Vilcanota River, awaits us with its famous fortress. We will admire its imposing architecture that stands out in the middle of the valley, reminding us of the splendor of the Inca civilization.



On our way back to Cusco, we will stop in Chinchero, where we will visit its small chapel and its archaeological center. Like Pisac, this charming town stands out for its indigenous market, although smaller, but rich in traditions and authentic textiles.



Finally, we will conclude our day in the city of Cusco, leaving you at your hotels so you can rest and remember with joy the experiences lived in the wonderful Sacred Valley of the Incas.
