•Return: To Soraypampa for lunch with regional dishes.

•Return to Cusco: End of the day.

•Breakfast: At the hotel in the morning. Tour start: Between 06:30 am and 06:45 am. •First stop: Chinchero Town (a weaving town).


•Second stop: Salt mines and chocolate tasting in the village of Maras.


